



Work Based Learning period

- 1) Work Based Learning should have a minimum of 600 and a maximum of 840 hours, for the course length;
- 2) This period can be split in one, two or three ocasions, being adapted to each partner characteristics;
- 3) 100 hours correspond to one month of Work Based Learning;
- 4) Students should be placed in public or private organizations, chosen by schools and VET providers, that fit the job description of the course and where they can perform the main activities therein described.
- 5) The course Work Based Learning is prepared for an Erasmus Pro KA 1 VET PRO application. Therefore, a minimum of three consecutive months should occur.
